ABOUT THE HOUSING AUTHORITY

The Kitsap County Consolidated Housing Authority serves all of Kitsap County excluding the City of Bremerton. It is administered by a seven-member Board of Commissioners. The Board is composed of the three Kitsap County Commissioners, the Mayors of the cities of Bainbridge Island, Port Orchard, and Poulsbo, and a resident from one of the Housing Authority projects.

The Housing Authority has formed non-profit organizations and limited partnerships to facilitate acquisition and construction of public and private housing and other community developments. The Housing Authority owns and operates over 800 units of affordable housing in 12 dwelling complexes including low rent public housing. It administers the Self-Help Housing Program of the Farmer's Home Administration and contract with the Bremerton Housing Authority to administer the Section 8 Housing Assistance Payments Program. In addition, the Housing Authority administers numerous other federal grants.

The Housing Authority has approximately 50 employees and expended \$16 million in 2000.
